- During the college/university term, you would be restricted to only 20 hours per week.
- Will be allowed full-time on campus, leading to 40 hours of work per week, during holidays and vacations.

- Curricular Practical Training (CPT)


you will get twice as much money from these programs, but you need to find a company on your own that is willing to hire you
