## BENEFITS TO APPLY IN CANADA

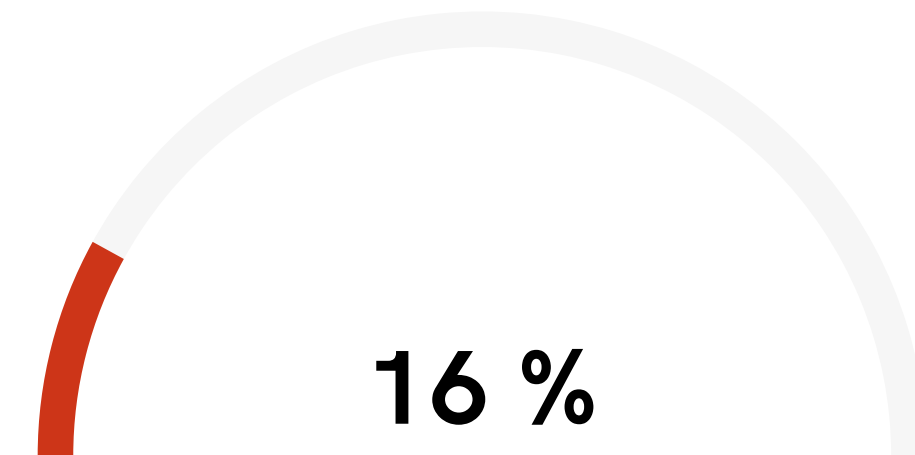
### 1. Availability

# What do you need to educate in Canada?

STEP 1: Choose the universities

STEP 2: Register in the electronic application system or on the university website

STEP 3: Prepare documents for the application for admission:

Document confirming previous education ,GPA ,Motivation letter ,letter of recommendation

Step 4: Take TOEFL or IELTS - a test that confirms knowledge of English

STEP 5: Take the SAT or ACT - School Curriculum Tests

STEP 6: Prepare a portfolio, pass other tests

STEP 7: Pay the Application Fee

STEP 8: Submit an application and wait for a response from the university

# Peculiarities of education in Canada

There is no free education in Canada. Both Canadian citizens and foreigners must pay for their studies. A year of college will cost 11-17,000 CAD, university - 17-25,000 CAD. Another 10-12,000 CAD will have to be paid for educational materials.

The vast majority of Canadians are immigrants from Europe, mainly French Canadians (about a third of the country's population). That's why student should know basic knowledge of French
