

# SCHOOL EDUCATION IN ITALY, THE WHOLE TRUTH!



- European education has always been of high quality and prestigious. Italy is a country that provides an excellent European education. Therefore, many residents of different countries choose Italy to study. Some need general secondary and higher schools, others need language or culinary schools, and others need to study design and fashion



- Children of foreign citizens living in the country for a long time have the full right to study in Italian schools. Therefore, school in Italy is not a problem for foreigners. Documents to schools in Italy are submitted by parents or guardians of children.



## Primary school

- Primary school, for children 6–10 years old. The program is designed for 5 years. They begin with the study of arithmetic, writing, reading, drawing, music. Religious studies – at the request of parents. Exams at the end of it are not given, but a diploma is issued.

# SECONDARY SCHOOL

- Compulsory for children aged 11–14 years, the term of study in it is 3 years. After graduation, a state exam is taken, it is necessary for the transition to the second stage of secondary education



## MEDIUM HIGH SCHOOL

This is the highest level of education in secondary school. In fact, this is an analogue of our technical schools and colleges. Education is provided to children from 14 to 19 years old. Accordingly, it lasts 5 years. In Italy, these are lyceums of various profiles

THE SCHOOL WEEK RUNS FROM MONDAY TO FRIDAY. THE MAXIMUM STUDY LOAD IS 6 HOURS A DAY.

- The academic year lasts about 9 months and is divided into 2 semesters (semesters).

Classes begin in mid-September and end in mid-June.

Holidays are also provided.

After five years of elementary school, that is, when Italian children turn 11, they move on to secondary school. But this is a different school, with different teachers and classmates.

Next is the lyceum. All lyceums in Italy are specialized. Therefore, a student at 14 years old should think very carefully about where to go to study further.
