



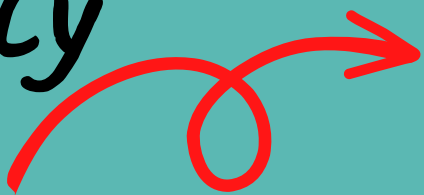

Charles university

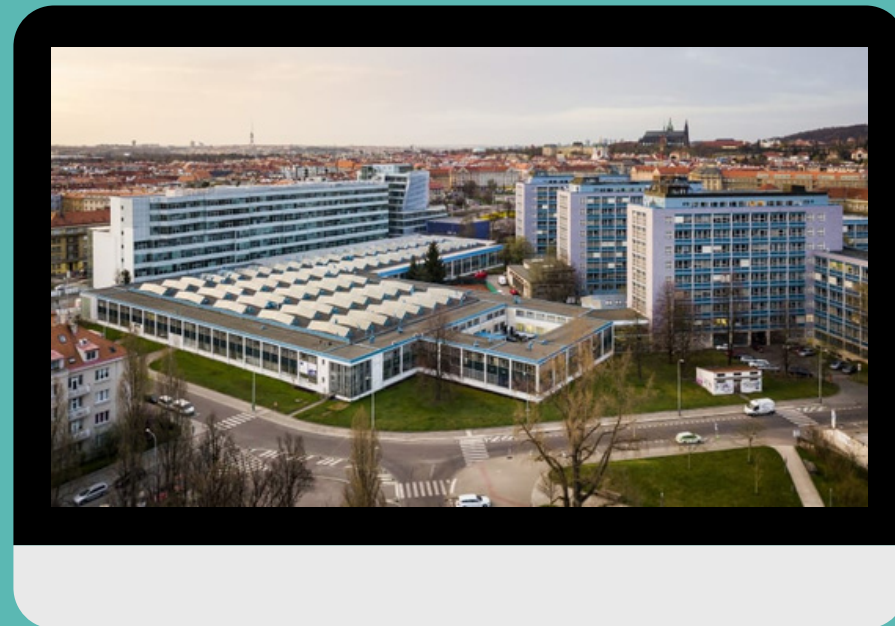


- the most historical, oldest university.

Czech Technical university



- More than 24,500 students study at eight faculties of the university.
- The training is conducted according to 115 programs in 419 specialties.
- CVUT students actively participate in international exchange programs. Every graduate of the Master's degree has spent at least 1 semester abroad.

Masaryk university



Masaryk University consists of 9 faculties, including more than 200 departments.

Training is conducted in more than 1400 specialties.

Masaryk University is the most popular among applicants of the Czech Republic. For several years in a row, the university has been leading in the number of applications submitted to it.

There are 40,844 students studying at the university, 7021 of them are foreigners.

The university has research institutes, such as the International Institute of Political Science and the Central European Institute of Technology.

Individual lectures and even entire courses at the university are taught by professors of prestigious European and American universities, heads of large enterprises, as well as high-ranking government officials, diplomats from around the world.

At Masaryk University, you can study two or more specialties at the same time.

Gymnázium Nad Kavalírkou

It is a comprehensive 8-year gymnasium with intensive teaching of computer science and mathematics, as well as foreign languages. English is studied throughout the course, with German, French or Spanish added from the 2nd year of study. The training is supplemented by language trips abroad.



Gymnázium Čakovice

The gymnasium offers a 6-year and 4-year general education program. The 6-year program has an increased number of computer science hours. The gymnasium conducts in-depth training in foreign languages. In addition to English, you can study German, Spanish, French, Russian, Latin and Chinese. In addition to classical English lessons, a conversational English language workshop with a native speaker is organized.



Habitation

A hostel is the most affordable way to rent accommodation for a student in the Czech Republic. Of course, if the university has such an opportunity. According to statistics, there are about 61 thousand places in dormitories for more than 300 thousand students. Thus, the rest should look for an alternative option.
