You can also do the activity on the board,


You can also do the activity on the board cut out food from magazines and newspapers and glue it on the board to practice grammatical constructions.



Board games are a great way to raise motivation in class, you can use them to repeat the topic of food and the construction I like/don't like/do you like?




This game is easy to play, pick a card and name the answer in time.
